## **2. ABOUT THE TRUST**

Sri Ranganatha Paduka Vidhyalaya Trust (SRPVT) which runs, Veda padasalas, Schools, a full-fledged college and Ghosala was founded at the divine direction of HH. Sri Vedantha Ramanuja Mahadesikan Sri. Thirukudanthai Andavan of Srirangam Srimad Andavan Periyashramam in the year 1968 by Sri T.S. Rajam, son of Sri T.V. Sundaram Iyengar founder of the TVS Group as the Founder Trustee. Other eminent trustees at the time of formation of the Trust included Sri T.S. Santhanam, son of Shri. T.V. Sundaram Iyengar; Smt. Prema Srinivasan, wife of Sri. T.S. Srinivasan; Sri K. Venkatachari, son of Late Sri R. Krishnamachariar; and Sri M. Srinivasan, son of Late R. Madhavachariar, who later become the Judge of the Supreme Court of India. Sri T.S. Rajam was the first Chairman and Sri M. Srinivasan was the first Secretary of the Trust.

### **2.1 CHARITABLE & SOCIAL REACH ACTIVITIES OF THE TRUST**

**Sri Ranganatha Paduka Vidyalaya Trust**, runs Veda Padasalas, Schools, a regular higher education institution, and Goshala, In its mission to maintain and encourage the Vedic studies Sanskrit, shastras and oriental knowledge, the Trust educates the interested youth from the marginalized section of the society in its Veda Padasalas run at seven different locations across India.

The Trust also engages in imparting higher education in its regular Autonomous college at Srirangam particularly from the marginalized and economically deprived section of the society situated in villages in and around 50 KMs radius from the college located in Srirangam , Thiruvanaikaval , Tamil Nadu. The Trust also maintains Ghosalas for protection of aged and distressed cows & Bulls at Srirangam and near Madurai where more than 200 cows are sheltered, fed and protected.

The Trust also runs two schools at Srirangam where students are given education at concessional fees with free transport facility.

#### **4. BRIEF ON VEDA PADASALA**

The Vedha Padasala activity established in 1968 at Srirangam is imparting Vedic & Sanskrit education along with oriental learnings like sastra, sutras etc. with traditional methods to the poor and needy eligible youth with the purpose of preserving the values of ancient heritage & culture and to impart, to sustain and propagate the study of ancient Vedas and oriental education to the future. The Padasalas are located at the following places.

1) Srirangam, T.N. 2)Thiruchanur, A.P. 3) Vrundhavan, U.P. 4) Vaduvor, T.N. 5) Thiruvahindrapuram, T.N. 6) Srimushnam, T.N. and 7) Aurangabad, Maharashtra. Over 100 students are taught and trained free of cost through these Padasala where the students are given free food & accommodation and maintenance. They are also given financial support to continue to pursue the path of our ancient customs and practices to preserve the Heritage and culture of Land. To keep the students well trained in the contemporary requirements and to be more functional in the society, computer literacy and English is also included in their training in three Padasalas with affiliation with universities for Shiromani (B.A.). Setting up a computer center, upgrading the facilities and providing better remuneration to teaching staff and provide financial support to students in all these Padasalas will lead to good quality training while ensuring expansions. These will require financial support in the form of contributions including CSR support.

## 5. ABOUT GHOSALA

With 200 cows in care, the Goshala combines traditional rearing methods with modern technology to maintain a happy herd of cows and bulls. The Ghosala operate on a non-commercial model, hence more than 80% of the cattle are aged and non-milk bearing. The welfare of the cows, bulls and calves is of primary importance in the Ghosala. A new Ghosala is being set up at Amur Village near Thiruvarur, Tamil Nadu to expand and provide more facilities to the cattle. There are plans to convert into energy and fertilizer the waste emerging from the Ghosala. The new projects are envisaged at the cost of Rs. 1.60 Crores.

Through the Ghosala we uphold the principles of protecting the cattle, which has been an integral part of Indian culture since time immemorial.

The new Goshala at Amur will be spread over 1.50 acres with scope for further expansion. At the initial stage, the Goshala shall house up 350 to 450 cows. Required grazing area is also made available adjacent to the compound. The infrastructure covers bathing, watering feeding and waste processing area. A separate unit for Urine and dung collection for Fertilizer Production and supply will be built.

## 6. BRIEF OF THE COLLEGE

Srimad Andavan Arts and Science College (Autonomous), a Co-educational higher education institution was established in 1996 at the behest of founder HH. SriMushnam Peria Andavan, Sri Rangaramanuja Mahadesikan Swamiji of Srirangam Srimad Andavan Periya Ashramam, Srirangam and inaugurated by the then President of India, Shri.Shankar Dhayal Sharma .The college is affiliated to Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli. With the continued support and vision of HH. SriMushnam Chinna Andavan Sri Varaha Maha Desikan swamiji the present head and pontis of the Ashramam, the trust board and the college engages to make men better and manifesting them to be perfect and good citizens which is the motto of the higher education provided at the college.

Srimad Andavan Arts & Science College provides a learning space to nurture the dream of every student a large part being from rural background. The college was recognized by University Grants Commission under 2f & 12 B Scheme and was bestowed with Autonomous status in 2014. Presently the college offers 15 Under Graduate Programs, 13 Post Graduate Programmes, 10 M.Phil. Programmes and Ph.D Programmes in 12 disciplines.

### 6.3 CONSESSIONS SUPPORT AND FACILITIES TO THE STUDENTS

- a) The vision of our founder is empowering youth particularly the rural youth through value based higher education so as to create knowledge embedded society with the focus on culture, tradition and spirituality. The college managed by the Trust strongly believes that “Social upliftment is possible through spreading the wings of higher education to the reach of the youth in the rural parts of the country”. The college has established closer links with the rural people of Tiruchirappalli district through various social reach activities particularly by providing the rural students free transportation. The college has been instilling holistic higher education for the past 26 years and it has a rich legacy in empowering the rural youth thus enabling social & economic development of the rural areas. Students from socially and economically marginalized sections of the society situated for villages in around 50KMs radius from the college are nurtured and empowered with higher education.

28 buses run every day up to 50kms radius from the college to bring students from far villages free of cost to the college. This enables the marginalized section of the society in the far villages to confidently send the aspiring youth from their home for higher education with secured and time bound travel to the college. In the year 2022-23 about 2400 rural youth got benefitted through this free transport facility, which enable them to pursue higher education hassle free. More than 25,000 students from economically & socially marginalized rural youth have opted and completed their higher education in the last 25 years because of the free bus service provided.

- b) 184 of our efficient and dedicated team of faculty members 86 of them being Doctorate degree holders’ endeavor to make the students as responsible stake holders of the society while making them industry ready graduates. The college gives wings to the dream of every student and enables them to enhance their hidden talents through skill development, cultural activities and sports events.

- c) Compared to other private run institutions in Tiruchirappalli, the college charges much less fees, while it provides fee concessions through various scholarship schemes such as Meritorious Scholarship, Girl Child Scholarship, Scholarship for differently abled, Sportsmen Scholarship, Scholarship for the economically weaker section, Scholarships for students from TRIPLE I Schools and Scholarship for the wards of Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff. Every year around 3000 students get benefitted through the aforementioned schemes.
- d) The students of the college have brought laurels from various programs and competitions adding more stars to the galaxy of success. The college has well equipped state –of-art- laboratories, research center, Audio visual room and well stocked library with extensive collection of books, journals and e-resource center and play grounds. The Management as a part of its mission has taken up the task of providing quality higher education for the social upliftment of the students through diverse strategies such as free transport, scholarship schemes, skill training, career guidance etc.
